

WHAT DO YOUR GRADES MEAN?

Formative Assessments: These grades DO NOT COUNT towards your final score. They serve as feedback to you and your instructor. They do not carry any weight towards your final grade. However, if you do not take the final assessment, these formatives will be averaged and will serve as your final grade.

In order to progress from level to level and successfully complete your program, you will need to attain a score of a minimum of 70% in each level you complete. While attendance is important, it does not count towards your final grade.

Formative assessment grading scale:

5 – Excellent

An outstanding performance in which the student demonstrates maximum mastery of assessed skill/s.

4.5 – 4.9 - Very Good

Exceeds more than average performance in language skill/s and has achieved mastery of assessed skill/s.

4 – 4.4 - Good

A more than adequate performance in which the student demonstrates a basic competence of assessed skill/s.

3.5 – 3.9 - Adequate

An adequate performance in which the student demonstrates a general adequate competence of assessed skill/s.

0 - 3.4 - Inadequate

An inadequate performance. Failed to demonstrate an adequate mastery of assessed skill/s.

Final assessment grading scale:

90-100% - Excellent

An outstanding performance in which the student demonstrates maximum mastery of the required skills for his/her level.

85-89% - Very Good

Exceeds more than average performance in language skills and has achieved mastery of the required skills for his/her level.

79-84% - Good

A more than adequate performance in which the student demonstrates a basic competence of the skills for his/her level.

70-78% - At level

An adequate performance in which the student demonstrates a general adequate competence of the skills required in the level.

0-69% - Below level

An inadequate performance. Failed to demonstrate an adequate mastery of the skills necessary to be “at level”.
