HEALTH INSURANCE

Airport transfers can be arranged by NYLC at an additional fee. If you would like to request an airport transfer please contact an NYLC Advisor.

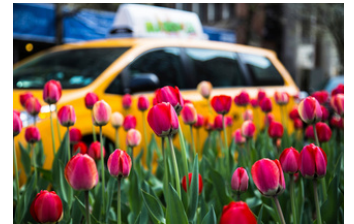
IMPORTANT: Please do not accept rides from strangers that approach you at the airport. It is recommended that you take yellow taxis. Yellow Taxis from **JFK Airport**: \$70.00 flat rate to any Manhattan destination + tolls. It is also customary to tip the driver 15% for good service.

Other forms of transportation:


JFK Airport: Air Train and transfer for the E ,J ,or Z train at Sutphin Boulevard. LaGuardia Airport: M60 bus to upper Manhattan, Q70 bus to 61st Woodside and transfer to a Manhattan bound 7 train.

Newark Airport: NJ Transit to PennStation.



TRANSPORTATION IN NYC



OMNY - OMNY is the contactless fare payment system for public transportation in the New York region. Simply use your contactless credit or debit card, smart phone, wearable device, or an OMNY card to tap and go. Contactless cards have this symbol  on the front or back. 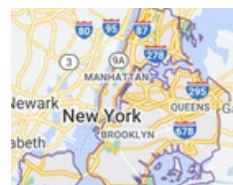

THE PLACEMENT TEST

The NYLC placement test has both written and oral components. The test will take approximately 30-40 minutes to complete. If you arrive in New York before your program start day, you may come to school any day, between Monday and Friday (10:00-3:00 PM) at either school locations or on Saturdays at NYLC Queens (10:00- 1:00 PM) to take the placement test.

The results of your placement test will determine your level of English, as well as your schedule for classes. *The schedule of your classes may be in the morning or in the afternoon.*



NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

Student Orientation is held virtually on Fridays, the week of Term 1 and Term 2 in a session. **Orientation is mandatory for F-1 students.** If for any reason you are unable to attend, you should plan to attend the following orientation.
