1. Documents

All new students need to **understand and sign the following documents** during their first week:

a.TheNYLC official Enrollment Agreement (the cancellation and refund policy is on this form)

b.The NYLC waiver form

c.You must also receive the *New York State*Disclosure Form "What you should know about
Certified Schools in the New York State ESL School
Registry". Ask for a copy if you do not have it!

You have the right and responsibility to understand the enrollment agreement, the refund and cancellation policy on the agreement, and also the NYLC waiver form that you are signing. Please see an NYLC staff member if you would like to request an explanation or to ask if there is a translation.

2. New Student Orientation

Look out for an email regarding our monthly, online NYLC orientation. This is MANDATORY for F-1 students, but we recommend orientation for all new students. There is valuable information about classes, activities, and life in NYC. You will meet your advisors and be able to ask questions about your studies.

3. Medical/health insurance

The consequences and risks of not having adequate **medical coverage** can be severe in the United States: for those without coverage a serious injury or illness can cost tens of thousands of dollars and there is a risk of poor health care. Students living in New York City may qualify for **FREE health insurance**. Please see an NYLC staff member for information on how to enroll for student medical (health) insurance. Students can enroll directly at www.kimberhealth.com/nylc. Please ask if you need help. You can scan the QR Code above to go directly to the website.



- 4. Student Expectations
- a. Make all payments on time— If you have an overdue payment you may not be able to attend
- Attend your Orientation— It is mandatory for F1 students to attend, but recommended for all new students
- c. On your first day of class, please do not write in your book— If the level is too hard or too easy please see the Academic Coordinator by the 3rd day of class and request a re-evaluation.
- d. If the coordinator agrees to switch your class within the first three days of the new session and you have not written in the book, there is no cost to change; if you switch after day three and you have marked your book, you will be charged for the new book.
- e. Attend your classes everyday— It is important to attend your classes. If you are an F1 student you need to be enrolled in an Intensive Language Program of 20 hours per

 1. Pay your payments ON TIME

 3. Attend classes on time EVERY DAY
 4. Take your bi-weekly & final exam
 5. Ensure your level is correct BEFORE writing in textbooks
 6. Return from your breaks on time for class
 7. If you are sick, please inform your NYLC advisor IMMEDIATELY

- f. **Be present and take your bi-weekly and final exams** If you miss an exam, please see your teacher to schedule a make-up exam. You must achieve a grade of at least 70 percent to progress to the next level.
- g. **Arrive and return from the break on time,** and stayfor the entire class.
- h. If you are sick, please call or emailthe school tolet the NYLC staff know you will be absent.
- i. **If you are sick for more than two days** or have a major illness or injury, and you are an F1 student, please call your Foreign Student Advisor right away.
