• For F-1 advising, NYLC has five F-1 advisors on its staff between the two branches of NYLC.

• For available hours, please contact the Front Desk student services or see the posted Office Hours sign.

• For University advising, please see either the Designated School Official at your branch or the Head of Student Life.

• Personal advising: Students may walk into the Advisor's office or can request a meeting with the appropriate staff member for information regarding health insurance, housing placement, driver's license or ID card application, bank account application, or for outside referrals to doctors, dentists, or other professionals. Additionally, student advisors are available for students' withdrawal requests, transfer requests and vacation requests.
